

Day 2: Sunday, June 27, 2010

Jim Thorpe to Walnutport

Canoeing/Kayaking • 10.5 miles

Please note: Meet at the train station in Jim Thorpe (**MUST PARK in Lot B**; no charge for Sojourn participants).

All **new Sojourners** must check-in at Wildlands Conservancy's

Lehigh River Sojourn registration table upon arrival.

IMPORTANT: Any participant paddling any type of kayak is required to have and wear a kayaking helmet.

DAILY PLAN:

Break Camp and load into personal vehicle.

Drive personal vehicle to the Train Station parking lot in Jim Thorpe (**MUST park in Lot B**); no charge for Sojourn participants).

6:30 - 7:30 .am. Registration. Breakfast served (by White Haven Bakery)

7:45 a.m. Safety Briefing. All participants are required to attend the daily safety briefing and wear a USCG-approved Type III personal floatation device (PFD) at all times on the river.

8:15 a.m. Launch from Jim Thorpe. Participants leave their personal vehicle in the parking lot for the day. Wildlands Conservancy will shuttle drivers back to Jim Thorpe at the end of the day to pick up their vehicles.

Noon Lunch along the Lehigh River. Special thanks to Yocco's The Hot Dog King for donating the hot dogs and chocolate milks!

After lunch Conservation Service Project at Lehigh Gap Nature Center. Help build birdhouses for the Center.

4:00 - 6:00 p.m. Take-out location: Walnutport Canal Association. End time depending on river conditions.

Drivers only board shuttle to pick up personal vehicles in Jim Thorpe. Drive back to Walnutport for dinner and evening activities. Dinner by Walnutport Canal Association. Entertainment by Headlong Retreat.
